NATIONAL FORUM, SLOVENIA

National forum was held in Maribor, Slovenia on 7th June 2013. Twelve members of National Stakeholders Platform, representatives of nine organisations, experts, social partners, employers and education/training institutions started partnership dialog on development and updating skills profiles needed and facilitate the process of career and lifelong learning process development, exchanged information, know-how, experiences and share good practices related to labour market - matching of skills supply and demand, career and LLL process development in Slovenia. At that occasion the national situation regarding skill mismatch, forecasting systems and interactions between the world of work and education/training was assessed; skill gaps and skills mismatches at the national labour market and relevant national good practices in partner country to discuss for transnational mutual learning were recognised. Conclusions from national forum will be elaborated in Benchmark report.
