

PUBLIC AREA

TRANSNATIONAL FORUM, AUSTRIA

With the purpose of development of intercultural frame for processing exchange and development of matching skills supply and demand, career and lifelong learning the first Transnational forum accompanied by visits of good practices was held in Graz, Austria on 20th and 21st June 2013. The forum aimed to provide a transnational exchange of information, know-how, experiences and good practices related to labour market - matching of skills supply and demand, career and lifelong learning process development. 34 participants of TNF - national and regional stakeholders from Austria as well as representatives of partners' organisations and stakeholders from project partners' countries discussed about involvement of the stakeholders and providers in interaction between the world of work and education/training, career and lifelong learning process, identified innovative elements of national/regional labour market policies in that area and innovative elements of policies, practices that can be transferred and adapted to the partners' country needs. Conclusions from TNF will result in Benchmark report which together with recommendations will be further discussed at the transnational conference, in January 2014.
